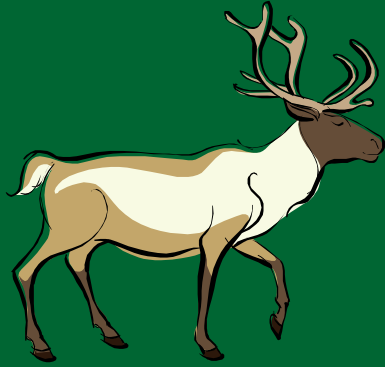

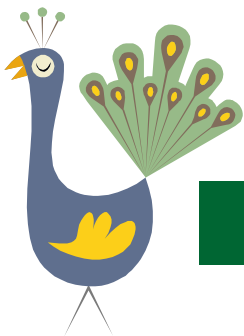

Guided Tour on a **Nature Train(s)** which **brings the natural world to life** and children learn through adventure! See a rich variety of trees and wildlife around our 500acre estate. Watch out for native red deer, badgers, foxes, squirrels and many more native species of wildlife. See trout and salmon glide in the clear waters of our rivers and lakes which eventually flow into the River **Blackwater**. If you're really lucky you may spot an otter devour a brown trout dinner! On route you are guaranteed to spot a mountain hare or the swooping attack of a kestrel or hen harrier. Discover many **rare** and **threatened** species of evergreen trees dating back to the ice age! What lurks among the Heather at Millstreet Country Park? What are bog –bodies and how is peat formed? See the **largest Red Deer Farm** in the South of Ireland. Wave and welcome our newest arrivals- the baby deer fawn.....

Millstreet Country Park reaches back into **history** and time and showcases a phenomenal array of historical attractions – which preserve and interpret life as it was thousands of years ago! Students will view a Standing Stone Circle Complex and Stone Alignment, Sheppard's Hut, Hedge School Site and more.... Finally all students get the opportunity to make a wish at the Wishing Well.....
